

How to Use Your Canva Sign Templates

Sugarcoated Cake School — Cake Shed Sign Kit

Each sign in this pack is a Canva template. When you click the link, it opens a copy in your own free Canva account.

You edit your version, the original stays untouched.

Step 1 — Click your template link Use the link provided for the sign you want to open.

Step 2 — Sign in or create a free Canva account Go to canva.com and sign up for free if you don't already have an account. It takes about two minutes.

Step 3 — Your copy opens automatically Canva creates a fresh copy in your account. Your changes will never affect the original or anyone else's version.

Step 4 — Click on any text to edit it Tap or click any text on the design and type in your own details — business name, product name, price, contact info, and so on.

Step 5 — Add your logo Click the logo placeholder and delete it. Then click Uploads on the left panel, upload your logo, and drag it into place.

Step 6 — Add your QR code (Payment sign only) Delete the QR placeholder and upload your own QR code image. Generate it free from your Revolut, PayPal, or SumUp app.

Step 7 — Download and print Click Share in the top right, then Download. Choose PDF Print for the best quality. Print at home or send to a print shop.
